DOWNSTREAM NOTIFICATION AND PUBLIC NOTICE
INGRAM'S MILL WATER TREATMENT PLANT (Facility ID #15-43356)

Dear Sir or Madam:

Aqua Pennsylvania, Inc. (Aqua PA) treats and distributes potable water to many of the communities in the five counties that surround the City of Philadelphia. Aqua PA's treatment facilities include the Ingram's Mill Water Treatment Plant (Ingram's Mill WTP), which is located at 780 Creek Road, West Chester, PA 19380 (Chester County).

You are receiving this notice because you have a facility or are a municipality by a waterbody within 20-miles downstream of our Ingram's Mill WTP. According to the Pennsylvania "Storage Tank and Spill Prevention Act of 1989" [P.L. 169, No. 32, Section 903(a)], Aqua PA is required to notify both downstream municipalities and water users annually in writing of the registered chemical and fuel oil aboveground storage tanks (ASTs) located at our Ingram's Mill WTP site.

The following are the registered ASTs currently in use at the Ingram's Mill WTP:
