Composting

Residents have the option of using a composting service called **Waste Well**. Waste Well picks up food scraps from customers and delivers them to a composting processing facility. Each spring, their customers receive a lot of finished compost as well. [Find more information](#).

For service on your well equipment, you will generally find a label on your water tank from the firm that performed the original installation. [PECO](#), a part of Exelon Corp is the electric service provider in Chadds Ford. Starting in January 2011, PECO will only "deliver" electricity to your home or business. Consumers will be required to select an electric generation company as part of Pennsylvania's Utility Competition initiative.

Sewer

Domestic Sewer can be handled by an on-site septic system or through community sewage treatment plant. There are two municipal Waste Water Treatment facilities owned and operated by the Chadds Ford Township Sewer Authority. In addition, the Springhill Farm Condominium Association and Knights Bridge Association operate private wastewater treatment facilities for their individual communities.
